To promote understanding of human rights, women's rights, and democracy among the 100 staffs from governmental and civil society organizations and to advance their capacities in practice and advocacy for it, in Balkh, Jowzjan and Samangan provinces.

To enhance capacities and knowledge of 100 members of provincial councils and CDCs members on human rights, women's rights, and democracy in Balkh, Jowzjan and Samangan provinces to improve their alert contributions in discussions, planning, practices and monitoring processes.

Output: Research on forms of violation against women; Finding women rights violation cases over Afghanistan; Documenting the cases and its use in TV program production; Airing the messages on awareness raising on women rights and its protection in daily TV programs to 15 provinces of Afghanistan (6 minutes per program, totally in 312 programs during one year life of project); Collecting people's views and opinions on the aired messages and its application in the next programs; Facilitating the advocacy for the identified and aired cases;
